(That's equivalent to the water that would fit into the Rogers Centre with its roof closed! That's money that goes back in buildings.)

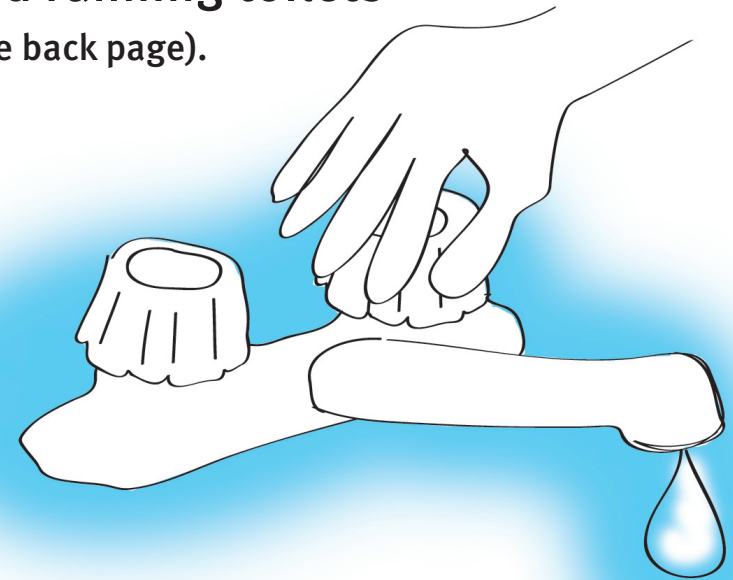


You can turn off water when you're not using it.
