Proposal

This is a proposal to amend the Zoning By-law to permit six new residential buildings, a community centre and a public park within the Firgrove-Grassways Community. A total of 941 residential units are proposed, of which 236 units are replacement TCHC units, 107 are new TCHC units, and 600 are new market units. The 152 residential units at Needle Firway are proposed to be retained and refurbished. The proposal also include replacement of community space, the outdoor pool, childcare centre, and introduction of a park, retail spaces and new roads and private driveways.

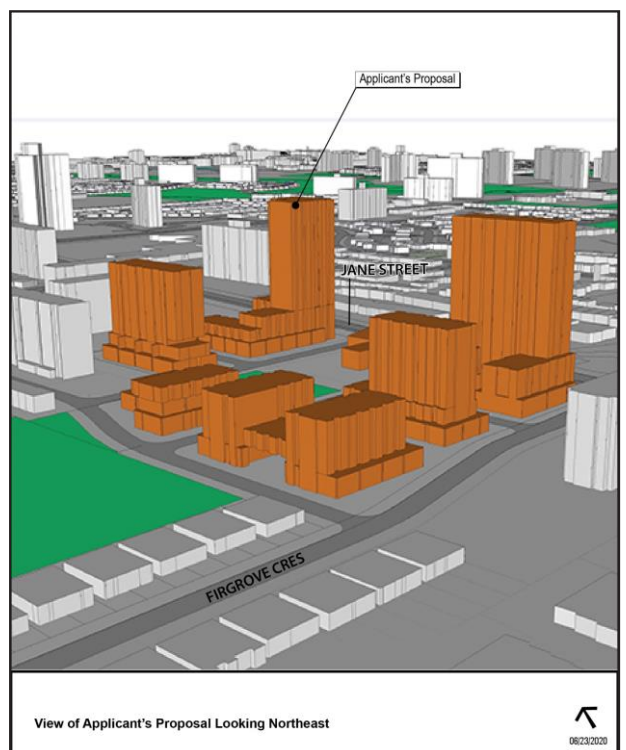
