This Addendum forms part of the above mentioned RFQ document and is to be read, interpreted, and coordinated with all other parts. The following revisions supersede the information contained in the original RFQ documents issued for the above-named project to the extent referenced and shall become part thereof.

The following information supplements and/or supersedes the RFQ document issued on **October 17, 2018**.

1. SUBMISSION DEADLINE

The **Submission Deadline**, as stated in the RFP Timetable, has been changed to **November 5, 2018**. The closing time remains the same at **2:00:00 p.m. Toronto time**.

2. CLARIFICATIONS

Q1: What was the successful AC Model# and Manufacturer Name of the previous Portable Self Evaporating AC Tender?

A1: *The information does not relate to this RFQ and will therefore not be disclosed.*

Q2: What are the four addresses/locations for the bulk delivery of these units? How many units to each location?

A2: *We cannot confirm the addresses yet. They will be located within the geographic boundary of the City of Toronto.*

Q3: TCHC is asking for a two (2) year warranty on these AC units while the industry standard from the manufacturer is only (1) one year. What is the reason for the different warranty period in this RFQ? Does this mean the Proponent is responsible for the second year warranty?

A3: *This is TCHC's expectation. The cost for the additional warranty can be included in the overall pricing which will be considered as one price for proponent's submission. This way TCHC would be dealing with the single vendor that supplied the units within the warranty period, and not the manufacturer.*

- Q4: Due to the large number of units required and the potential cost and carrying charges implications would TCHC provide successful Proponent with 50% of the total successful bid cost at award of tender to offset the long delay timelines of April 2019? Note: TCHC can take up to 45 days after receiving and approving the delivery invoices to actually pay successful Proponent which adds to the carrying time of the costs for this RFQ.
- A4: This can be negotiated with the successful vendor but there is no guarantee that 50% bid cost will be paid up-front. TCHC's standard practice does not allow this.**
- Q5: What is the reason for the Pollution Insurance requested in this RFP?
- A5: Pollution Insurance is not required. Section 4.1.5 (Contractors Pollution Liability Insurance) of the main RFQ Main document is therefore deleted in its entirety.**
- Q6: Closing date – is it still tomorrow at 2:00 pm (Oct 31)?
- A6: Submission Deadline for this RFQ has been changed to – Monday, November 5; at 2:00 p.m.**
- Q7: Do the locations have the capability to have a container dropped to site for offloading completely into the building?
- A7: The warehouse will have capability to receive the full container**
- Q8: Are you aware that no portable air conditioner has an EER Rating > 10?
- A8: We understand there are portable ACs with >10 EER**

All other terms and conditions remain the same.
