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This Addendum forms part of the above mentioned RFPQ document and is to be read, interpreted, and coordinated with all other parts. The following revisions supersede the information contained in the original RFPQ documents issued for the above-named project to the extent referenced and shall become part thereof.

The following information supplements and/or supersedes the RFPQ document issued on **March 05, 2019**.

1. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q1. If currently a TCHC vendor is on the mechanical list but did not attend the mandatory information session on March 13, are they allowed to submit their pre-qualification under this RFPQ? Will they still be able to bid on any of the estimated locations for upcoming mechanical work?

A1. Attendance at the mandatory information session is a prerequisite for any Proponent to be considered for pre-qualification under RFPQ 19084. All Proponents, including those currently on a TCHC roster, must make a full submission to be eligible for RFPQ 19084. Only pre-qualified vendors under RFPQ 19084 will be eligible to bid on subsequent RFQs for the locations listed.

Q2. We are interested in the Request for Prequalification for Comprehensive Mechanical and Electrical System Upgrades at the various TCHC locations (RFPQ 19084). We just realized that there was a mandatory information session on March 13, 2019. Please advise if we are still able to submit to this prequalification.

A2. Proponents who did not attend the information session on March 13, 2019 are not eligible to submit for this prequalification.

Q3. I am an electrical contractor that is interested in this opportunity. Am I eligible to submit?

A3. TCHC is looking for firms capable of delivering the full scope of mechanical and electrical construction services outlined in the RFPQ. Proponents are required to demonstrate experience with the full scope of work, and may elect to sub-contract other firm(s) for the RFPQ in order to achieve this. For clarification, TCHC intends to only enter into a contract with one Proponent per project.

Q4. Can TCHC please clarify that engineering and drawings will be done by a 3rd party and the RFPQ proponents are to execute only?

A4. TCHC has hired consultants to prepare mechanical and electrical designs for each of the projects listed as part of RFPQ 19084. Proponents are expected to provide construction services to implement the designs.

All other terms and conditions remain the same.
