

# Provincial election

## Dos and Don'ts



The provincial election will be held on **Thursday, June 2, 2022**. Here are a few reminders of what to do and what not to do.

### What to do



#### **Do vote.**

You can vote on June 2 or in advance. You should receive a Voter Information Card in the mail. Please consult [elections.on.ca](https://elections.on.ca) for information on advance voting and the location of your voting station.



#### **Do allow candidates to canvass in your building.**

It's any candidate's right to be able to access potential constituents for the purpose of canvassing, which includes knocking on doors, talking to tenants and leaving flyers behind with those tenants.



#### **Do put up election signs inside your home.**

Examples include in your window or on your wall.

### What not to do



#### **Don't put up election signs on your balcony or in common areas of your building.**

This is both dangerous and against the law.



#### **Don't share any personal information you're not comfortable sharing.**

This includes with candidates who come to your door, or with anyone else. TCHC will **not** share tenant lists with candidates or political parties. We respect tenant privacy.
