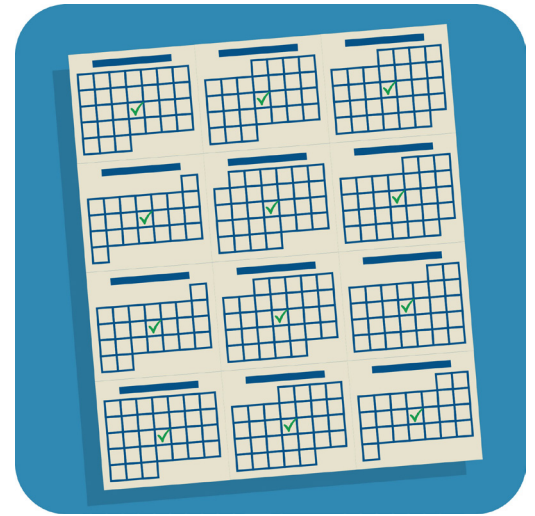
Fire safety is everyone's responsibility



Smoke alarms

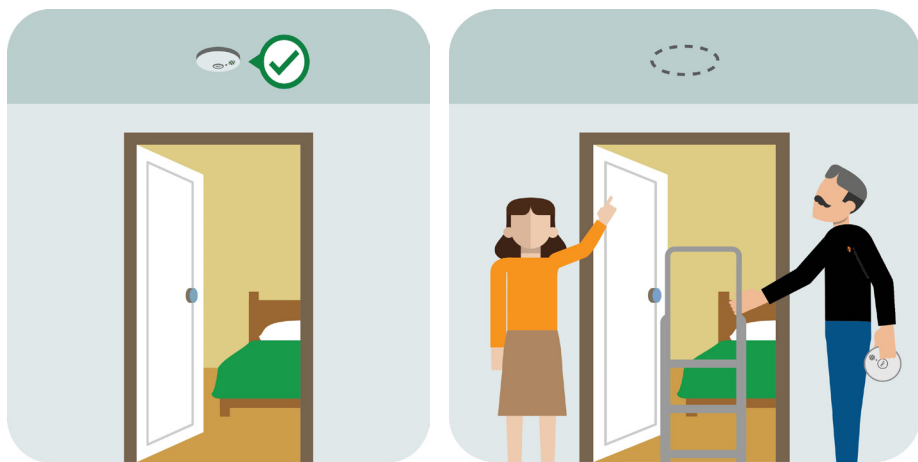
A working smoke alarm can save your life. Smoke spreads fast and a smoke alarm will give early warning to escape a fire safely.

Schedule regular tests



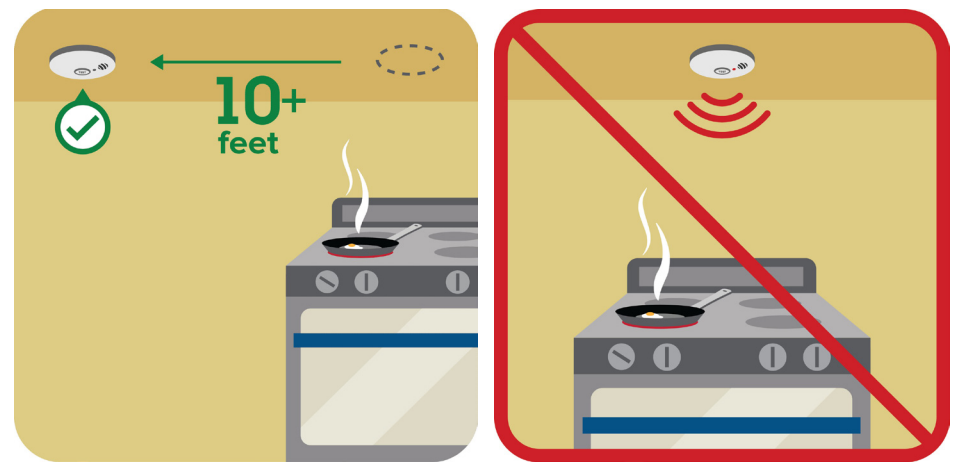
Test your smoke alarms every month by pressing the test button and listening for the alarm.

Missing or broken alarms



If your smoke alarm is missing or not working, speak with your Superintendent or call the Client Care Centre at **416-981-5500**.

False alarms



To prevent false alarms, smoke alarms should be at least 10 feet away from your stove. If your alarm needs to be moved, speak with your Superintendent.

Do not disable or unplug a smoke alarm, even temporarily, as you may forget to reconnect it. It is against the law to tamper with or disable a smoke alarm.
