



Service	Safety Measures
<b>Pools</b>	<p>All pools have opened with conditions including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A capacity limit (set at 15)</li> <li>• separate staff to monitor social distancing</li> <li>• signage</li> <li>• suspended use of equipment</li> <li>• sign in and screening and</li> <li>• no access to change rooms/washrooms.</li> </ul>
<b>Faith-based services</b>	<p>In-person faith-based services are permitted with conditions, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• capacity restrictions (max 10 people or 30% regular capacity)</li> <li>• disinfect high-touch surfaces after use</li> <li>• compliance with TPH guideline for places of worship</li> </ul>
<b>Gardens</b>	<p>Any person who uses community or allotment gardens must follow these guidelines/directions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• practise all established physical distancing measures,</li> <li>• meet cleaning and disinfecting requirements, and</li> <li>• comply with the TPH guidelines for Community and Allotment Gardens.</li> </ul> <p>The garden manager and garden members must sign the Toronto Public Health Community and Allotment Garden Declaration.</p>
<b>Sport fields</b>	<p>Sports fields can be used for training or practices, but not for games, scrimmages or other activities that will result in persons coming within two metres (six feet) of each other.</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Teams can train to a maximum of 10 individuals. This includes coaches, trainers, participants and spectators.</li> <li>• Those using the sports fields must keep two metres from others and wear a mask where physical distancing cannot be maintained.</li> <li>• Outdoor sitting furniture or other objects must be spaced at least two metres apart where possible.</li> </ul>
<b>Playgrounds</b>	Playgrounds will be opening with social distancing signage in place.
<b>Sports courts</b>	Sports courts have opened with social distancing signage in place.
<b>Cooling rooms</b>	Cooling rooms are open in TCHC buildings on an as needed basis with cleaning, capacity limits, and social distancing rules.
<b>Cleaning</b>	There continues to be increased cleaning and disinfection in all TCHC buildings and offices, with an additional focus on disinfecting frequently touched surfaces in common areas.
<b>Food security</b>	Food banks which agencies normally operate in TCHC buildings are still open, with special precautions for cleanliness and social distancing.
<b>In-suite capital Work</b>	For all visits to tenant units, staff or contractors must wear Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), maintain appropriate distancing and provide 24-hour notice of entry to the tenant.
<b>In-suite maintenance by vendors</b>	In-suite non-urgent demand maintenance and preventative maintenance by vendors has resumed. Vendors will take all safety precautions, including wearing the proper Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and practising social and physical distancing where possible with tenants and their fellow workers. Tenants will be given at least 24 hours' notice of entry before any in-suite work takes place.

<b>Parking enforcement</b>	Full parking enforcement has resumed, including visitor parking, staff parking, fire routes and non-designated areas.
<b>Closed</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All TCHC outdoor and indoor recreation spaces not listed above are currently closed.</li><li>• Offices remain closed for walk-in visits (meetings must be made by appointment only).</li></ul>
<b>Note</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>TCHC may suspend services or close a space in the interest of public safety.</i></li></ul>
