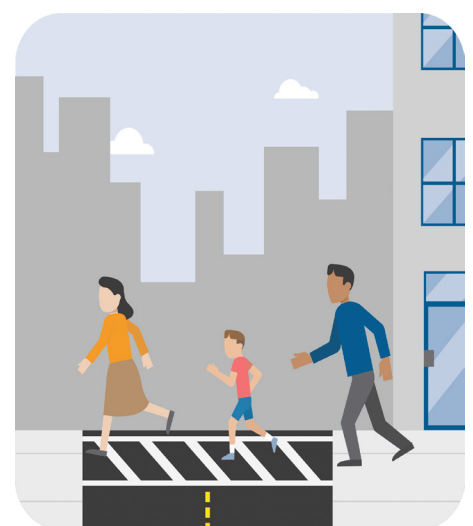
Fire safety is everyone's responsibility



Home escape

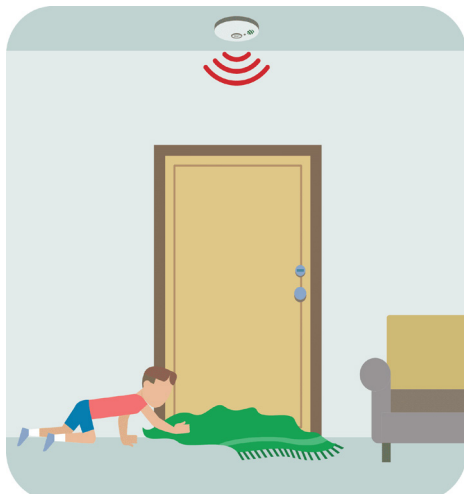
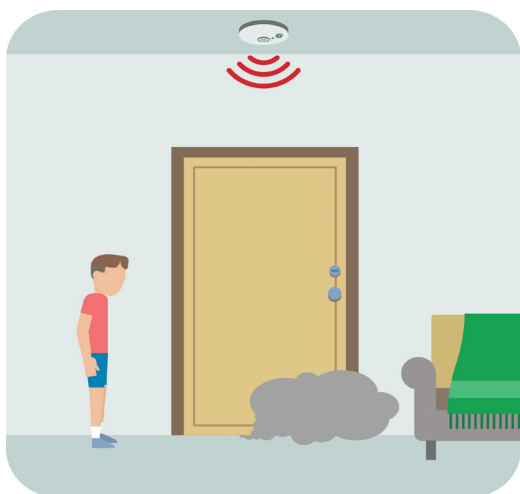
When a fire alarm rings, there is no time to waste. Have a plan and practise it.

What to do if you are evacuating the building



Always take the stairs; never use the elevator. Use the nearest exit and do not stop for anything. Once you are out, do not go back in for any reason.

What to do if you can't evacuate the building



If smoke or fire block all exits, stay in your unit. Keep your front door closed and seal any cracks with wet towels or sheets to keep smoke out. Call **9-1-1** to tell the Fire Department you are in your home. Wave a bright cloth from a balcony or open window to let firefighters know where you are.
