

Parking Permit Categories

Tenant Barcode Permits:

Tenant parkers will receive a Barcode Permit that allows the tenant to park at their *assigned* parking location and space where applicable, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, at one specified address and is not valid at other Toronto Community Housing addresses.

Non-Tenant Barcode Permits:

Non-tenants and commercial tenants will receive a Barcode Permit that allows the person to park at their *assigned* parking location and space where applicable 24 hours a day, 7 days a week at one specified address and is not valid at other Toronto Community Housing addresses.

Visitor Parking Permits:

All visitors may park on TCH property(ies) as designated by Visitor Parking Signage and must adhere to the Signage that is at the property location. Visitor Parking Permit requirements may vary between TCH Properties.

Short-Term Hanging Parking Permits are available to:

- A registered parker, whose vehicle is temporarily not in service due to accident or repairs and who is using a rental or loaned vehicle for a specified time period. It is the registered parker's responsibility to advise TCH and to request a Short Term Hanging Parking Permit from the Operating Unit/Contract Management office; otherwise the vehicle will be ticketed.
- A non-tenant requesting parking on TCH property for 11 months or less. The permit allows the non-tenant to park at one specified address and space where applicable, for the time period specified on the permit, and is not valid at other Toronto Community Housing addresses.

Vehicle On Duty Signs are available to:

- Contractors/Vendors who has regular business activities and a Standard Purchasing or Service Agreement with TCH to provide products or services
- Agencies that are publicly recognized and properly registered, non-profit organization that provides services to TCH tenants at TCH properties
