
Sign up for relief funds available through the Stone Soup Network



Thursday, August 11, 2022

The Stone Soup Network and partners have raised relief funds for Swansea Mews tenants who have been relocated away from their community.



How do I sign up?

The head of your household (listed on the lease) must go to https://forms.office.com/r/UT8uDVSLDY and fill out the form. Applications are due Thursday, August 18, 2022.

Is my information confidential?

Stone Soup will keep all information private and secure. Limited information will be given to TCHC to confirm your tenancy through the following steps:

- 1. You will need to consent for Stone Soup to share with TCHC that you have applied for these funds.
- 2. Stone Soup will contact TCHC to disclose your household has applied.
- 3. TCHC will contact your household to confirm you have applied for this program. We will also get your consent to share with Stone Soup that you are a TCHC tenant who has been displaced from Swansea Mews.
- 4. TCHC will confirm with Swansea Mews that you (as the applicant) is a TCHC tenant who has been displaced from Swansea Mews.
