

Advice TCHC on how to implement the Tenant Engagement System

The Tenant Engagement System

The Tenant Engagement System was approved by Toronto Community Housing's (TCHC) Board of Directors on July 19, 2019. It is the formal system of engaging tenants living in Toronto Community Housing.

The goal of the refreshed Tenant Engagement System is to increase tenant participation in local decisionmaking, as recommended in the Mayor's Task Force and Tenant's First Reports. Tenants



and staff have worked together over the past several years to develop a refreshed Tenant Engagement System that encourages and empowers more TCHC tenants toget involved in local decision-making in their community.

The model reflects the principles of the Tenant Charter, including all requirements for accessibility under the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act and TCHC's Human Rights, Harassment and Fair Access Policy. The Tenant Engagement System supports an inclusive and accessible environment that promotes dignity and respect, free of discrimination and harassment.

Guided by the principles for effective and meaningful engagement - Respect, Equity, Informative, Inclusiveness, Accessibility and Collaboration, TCHC is committed to a robust and effective tenant engagement process and equitable opportunities for all tenants.

The vision of the Tenant Engagement System is to foster relationships with tenants and build vibrant communities through diverse, inclusive and collaborative methods that gives all tenants of TCHC a voice and input in community-related decision-making.

The foundation of the Tenant Engagement System is the needs and priorities identified by tenants through a priority setting process. Tenant priorities inform the focus of all structures in the Tenant Engagement System. Tenant priorities will also inform our approach to partnership development and our program and servicedelivery model.

Tenant Advisory group:

How we got here

TCHC wants to create a group of tenants who advise TCHC on the implementation of Tenant Engagement System and tenant facing procedures within the system. Such as Tenant Action Fund (TAF) application form review, help plan upcoming tenant forums and overall implantation of TCHC's Tenant Engagement System.

Next steps

We are looking to establish the 2022 Tenant Advisory group by September, 2022. An information session will also take place in September. The first Tenant Advisory group meeting will take place in November.



Eligibility criteria

To be eligible to be part of the Tenant Advisory Group, you must bea tenant 16 years of age or older, who is committed to individual and community well-being, passionate about your community and looking toenhance your leadership skills. If this sounds like you will be a good fit, we encourage you to apply.

Personal attributes

You are interested in and committed to community well-being, are empathetic, a passionate collaborator and communicator, reliable, guided by an anti-oppression framework, are sensitive, respectful and have demonstrated leadership skills within your community.



Skills and qualifications

You are knowledgeable about the City of Toronto, communities in our city and tenants' needs and priorities. You also haveknowledge of Toronto Community Housing's policies and operations or have a strong willingness to learn.

Experience

You are involved in your community and/or have experience in community development and working with tenants through Tenant Councils, advocacy initiatives, ongoing events, allocating resources etc.



Tenancy

You are 16 years of age or older and on a Toronto Community Housinglease agreement.

Advisor roles and expectations

As a member of the Tenant Advisory Group, you will advise TCHC on the implementation of Tenant Engagement System and tenant facing procedures within the system. Such as TAF application form review, help plan upcoming tenant forums and overall implantation of TCHC's Tenant Engagement System.

This is a great opportunity to network, build your skills and gain strongcommunity engagement experience.

Members of the Advisory group are expected to:

- support an inclusive environment that promotes dignity, respect and is free of discrimination and harassment
- attend scheduled meetings

- promote the availability of funds
