Reminder: rent freeze ends for RGI tenants who had an income increase



On January 1, 2022, your rent increase will come into effect

Effective December 31, 2021, the provincial rent freeze will end. Based on changes in income, some tenants may have had a rent increase that was deferred to 2022. This increase will take effect in the payment due Saturday, January 1, 2022.

As part of your yearly rent review in 2021, you would have received a Notice of Decision. If your income changed and your rent increased, you would also receive an N2 notice that included the new amount but showed that you would not be expected to pay this new amount until January.

If you are on Pre-Authorized Payment (PAP) your new rent amount will be pulled automatically from your account in January.
