REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATIONS:

The CSU has produced an annual report to the TPSB since 2002 based on the directed content and format of the TPS Special Constable Liaison Unit. In 2019, due to a historical process gap, Management noted that the TCHC Board had never been provided with a copy of the report in advance of it being submitted to the TPSB. This was rectified starting with the 2019 report, which was presented in 2020.
