The planned capital upgrades of common areas at 220 Oak Street presented an opportunity for staff to consider community needs such as e-bike storage. As part of the capital work the building will also undergo extensive envelope and balcony repairs along with the replacement of mechanical/electrical systems over the next three years. The e-bike storage pilot will help TCHC understand the costs, along with the physical, technical and security requirements associated with this initiative.
